- A. What we must put off, lay aside or reject (12:1b)
 - weights
 - sin

B. How we need to run (12:1c)

- We are called to run with endurance so we can remain under the hard times
- Remember: faith that starts you in the race, but does not continue & finish, may not be real faith at all.

C. Jesus is the One we must always keep our eyes upon (12:1c)
